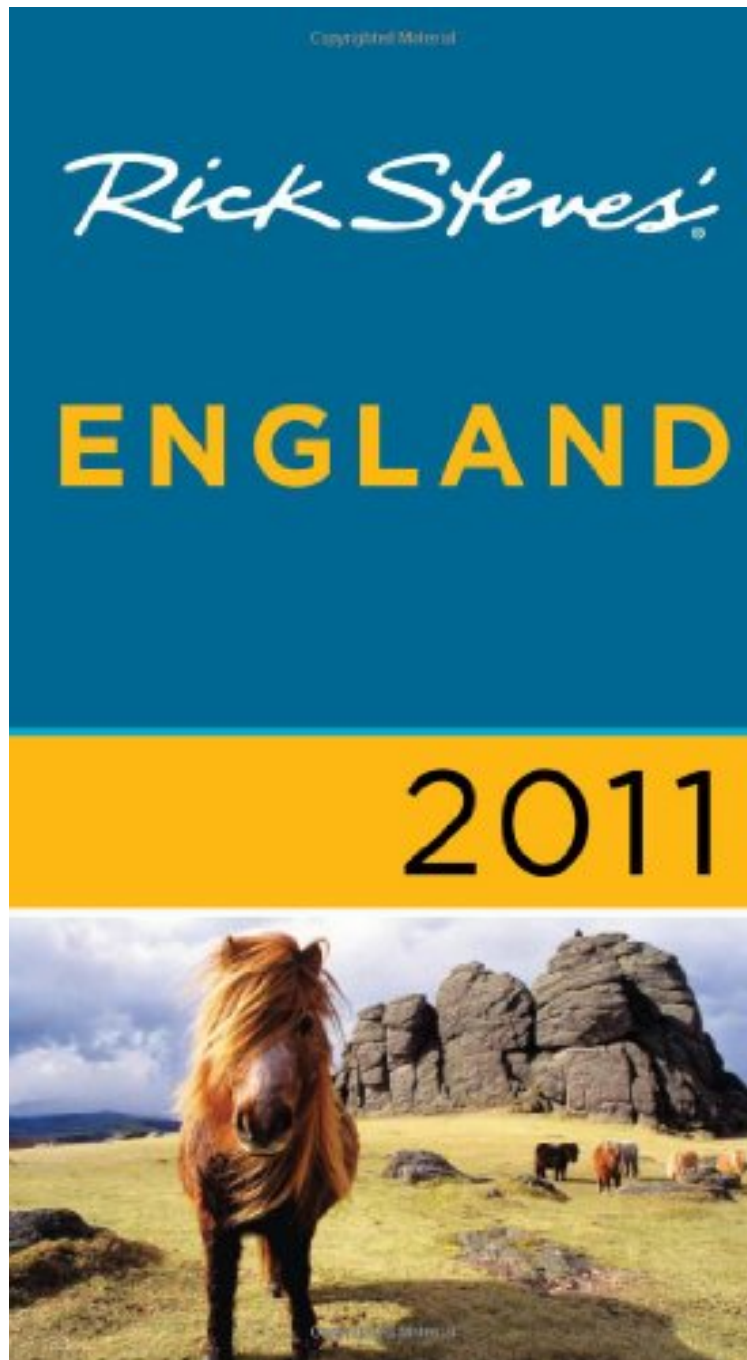

The text may be OK (see below), but as a Kindle book the publisher has done a dreadful job of quality control and layout design. The book is essentially non-navigable. The hyper-links in the Table of Contents are too few. Worse yet, the Index lists all the topics, but not only has NO HYPER-LINKs, and (believe it or not) there are NO PAGE NUMBERS in the index either. What this means is the user has no way to find what he is looking for, except to do a word search. And a search on some name might turn out 50 or more listings. What poor quality work by the publisher. Unacceptable. Rick Steve's should fire them.As for the text, I did a search on "Castle Combe," one of England's most beautiful small villages, and found next to nothing in the entire book. This suggests to me the book is not comprehensive. Perhaps it does London, Bath and Oxford well, but it falls short on smaller destinations.1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
