It could have been better if the book had a good map. Some mention here that there was a detachable map and some mention there was none. I did not receive any map along with the book.Its true that while visiting a place one good book cannot address all the aspects. Some of them good in maps, some of them good in suggesting restaurants/shops, some provide accurate information on reaching the places in the most easiest way,etc.If you are looking for a cheap, economical easy to carry book,this is it. Good for prioritizing and for its "guided tours" but ...By Ms. What-Day-Is-ItThis book is a solid resource if you want help prioritizing your activities in Barcelona -- that is, what to be sure to see and what can wait. In fact, we ventured into a museum that received mention but "no triangles" from RS, and indeed, the museum was merely "meh." This is also a good resource for figuring out when (during the day and on what days) to visit specific sites. Not surprisingly, RS provides some lovely narration to guide you through the Picasso Museum, La Sagrada Familia and other sites once you reach them. Absolutely do NOT rely on this book for its maps (try the impressive Rough Guide map) or for any detailed history of Barcelona (the Cadogan guide is wonderful in this regard). But to be fair, the RS guide doesn't promise much on these things in the first place. To our surprise, we consulted this book when we were in a dinner bind one evening, and the recommendation we chose turned out to be one of our favorites.In summary, if Barcelona is your destination (and it is worth at least 4 solid days), do not arrive with this book as your only resource. While it is excellent for its "bottom line" type info, also get yourself a good map and, if you want more historical and social context, a more detailed guide.26 of 27 people found the following review helpful. The most useful feature (there are tons) in the Snapshot city guide e-books are the self-guided tours through the museums. There are crowd-beating tips, updated cost, hours, locations, phone numbers, maps, self-guided walking tours in the city...Seriously, it's a no-brainer. Get this e-book. For so little money, you can save yourself a world full of headaches. He also points out cool things to see in the city that aren't in other tour books (the Sardana dances), and he gives invaluable tips of the good places to go for everything (food, entertainment, museums, neighborhoods, etc). Also, the local free tourist maps they give you are usually anemic by way of detailed, accurate information. Having this little tool as a backup is critical when you may not have time to hunt down bigger books and maps. It also gives you info about surrounding cities you may like to visit, as well as tips on language, money, phoning...Plus, it fits in your pocket (I used it on my iPhone with the Kindle reader). You don't look like a tourist dork reading your iPhone, like you do lugging around maps and books. You look way cooler...
