A tad difficult to follow at times (Rome has an absolute plethora of buses!) but a little planning before you set out will have you hopping on and off with confidence. You can wend your way as far afield as The Abbazio of Tre Fontane just past EUR with this, or discover the stops of

the #64 bus from Termini to St. Peter's (do watch out for pickpockets on this one - I speak from experience - caught one in the act!) I visit Rome every year (for the past 7) and have this with me all the time. Do remember to have bus tickets (bought at a tabac shop) with you - being caught trying to snag a free ride can result in a hefty fine. Oh yes, if caught in a downpour you can hop onto any bus that stops near a Metro station - underground is dry! And as for those 2-day visits - just plan to be there longer. There's more to Rome than a coin in a fountain... Ciao!
