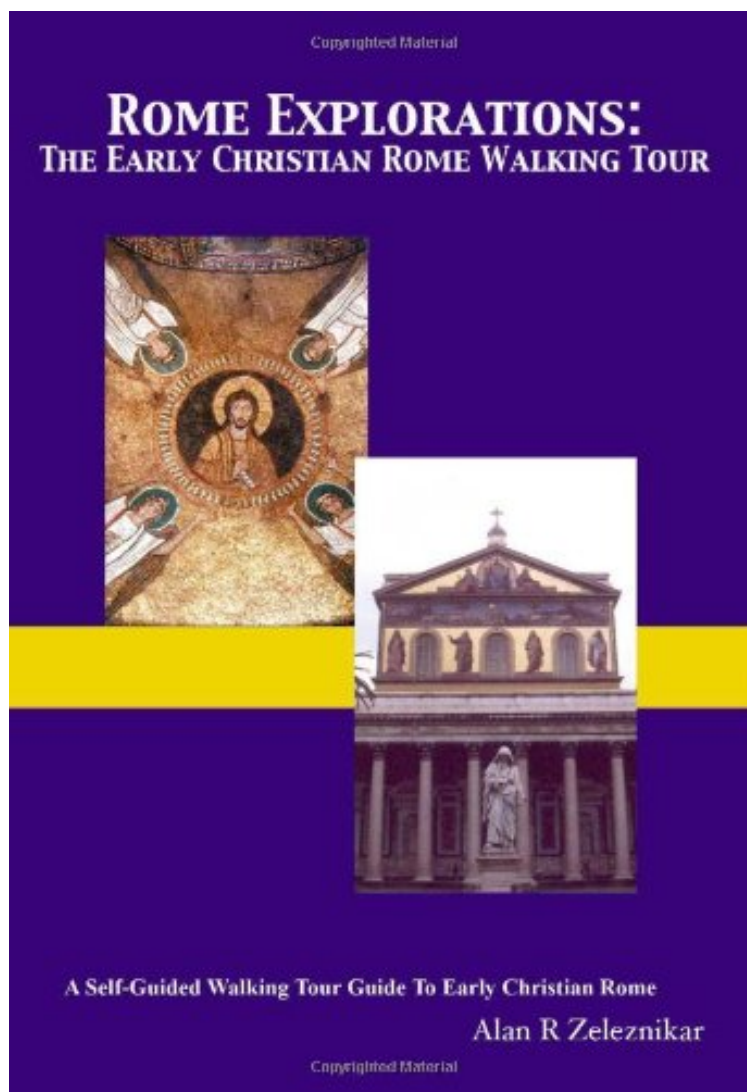

The one detraction is that the publishing is a bit of a home job and pictures are missing, smeared, or otherwise not terribly useful.
