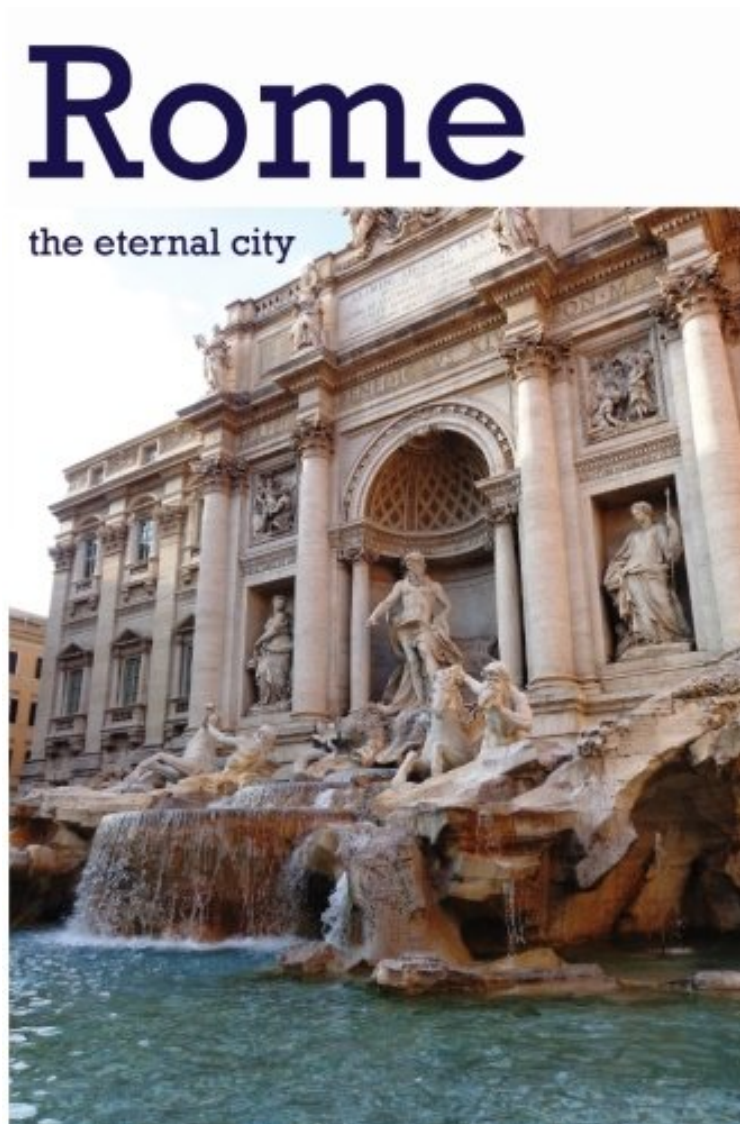

Every town is separated into zones, and - as if walking on the streets of the part of the town, we describe many details such as history, ambience, architecture, food, object interiors, as well as infrastructure in that part of the city. A large number of similar projects is in preparation which we plan to realize in the next three years when we switch to the next continent.
