By Spencer Means One side of this map is devoted to the Costa del Sol, roughly from Algeciras to Vélez-Málaga, with a bit of the lower interior of Andalucia (no farther inland than Antequera). If this is all you plan to use it for, it's probably a pretty decent road map. However, the reverse side, devoted to all of Andalucia, coast to coast, is naturally on a much smaller scale. If you're only planning to visit larger towns and major points of interest, and you'll be satisfied with the principal roads linking them, it should also be adequate, but little more than that. If you want to get off the beaten path, visit smaller villages, and explore the countryside, you will probably find it less useful. I've revised this review since my trip and added a star (I believe I was too harsh), but if you think you need a really detailed road map, this isn't it. By FFB441I recently took this map with me on a trip to Andalucia, during which we planned to do a lot of driving. This map was great! Over the course of 2 weeks, it was refolded several times (never along original fold lines) and used very heavily (ie not gently). Despite that, there are no rips or tears and, when the time came to fly back to the US, it was easy to fold it up accordion-style for packing. If you're planning to visit Andalucia in the coming months, be aware that (seemingly) ALL the roads are currently under construction there. However, it wasn't useful for anything. The new, high-speed toll road between Malaga and Cordoba, AP-46, is not on the map. The exit numbers are wrong. There are no map insets for big cities so there is no detail.
