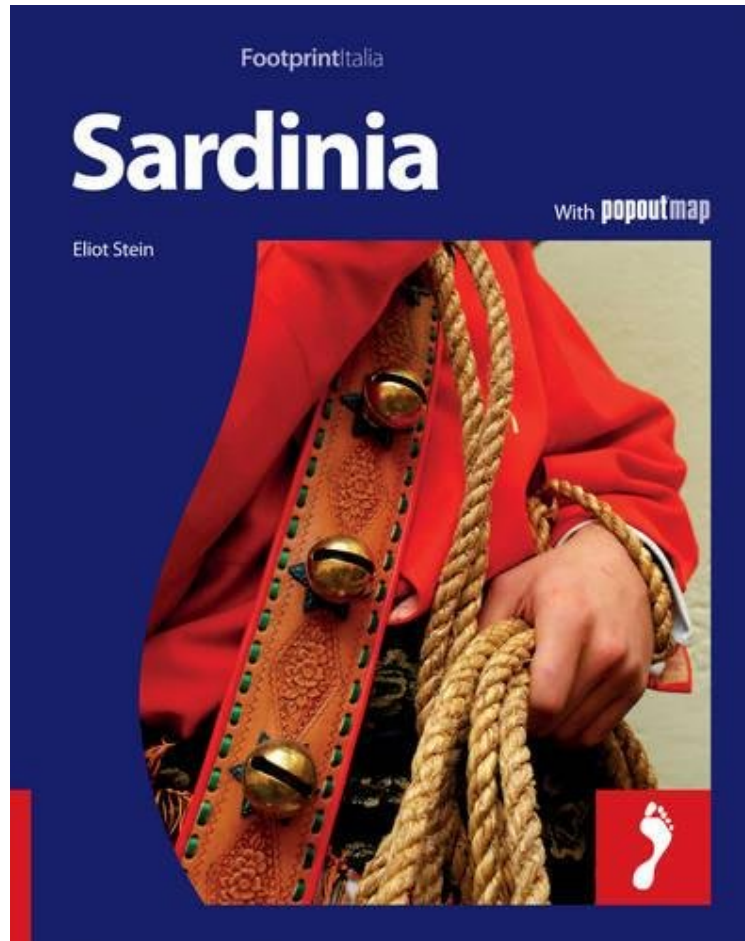

I wanted to compare them all so knew what to trust next time I plan a trip; Eyewitness Travel, Insight Guides, Rough Guides, and FootprintItalia were all the ones offered for Sardinia.FootprintItalia quickly became my "new best friend" as my girlfriend put it. The descriptions of towns were brief but as informative as the wordy books like Insight Guides or the Rough Guide. This one gave the sense of a guide leading you into his favorite sites, not just the most popular on the island or a list of all of the sights. He tells you the owner's name of his favorite cheap restaurants (and expensive but I didn't investigate

many of those) in the towns and what they are known for cooking. He knows this place. This book is truly a gem.
