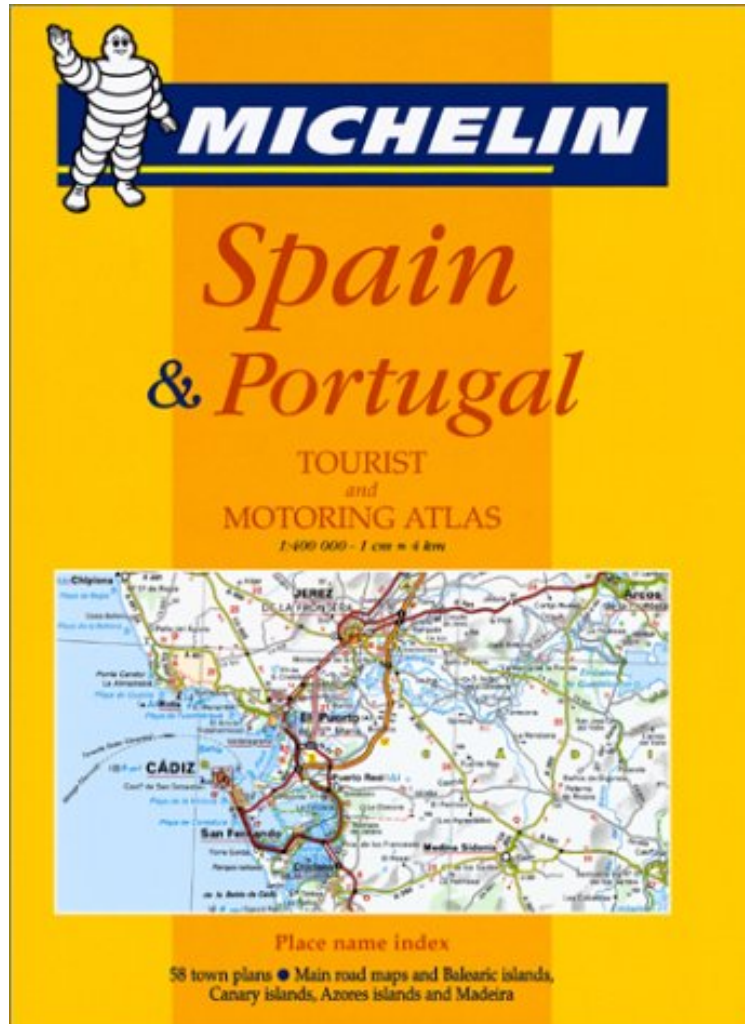

It shows you, in the best of scales, even the narrower tracks beaten mostly by local farmers and their animals. It presents all the main distances in general and millions of others, point to point, offers clear legends, easy-understanding symbols, a perfect use of the colours to give you an accurate perception of the landscape you will find, with excellent representation of surface

elevations, rivers, lakes, seashore and vegetation: You may feel like an eagle taking a high flight while hunting the best you can find there on the ground. As a Brazilian traveler, it's OK to me, but it could be a serious problem to one who deals with scales and distances only if it's expressed in inches/miles.
